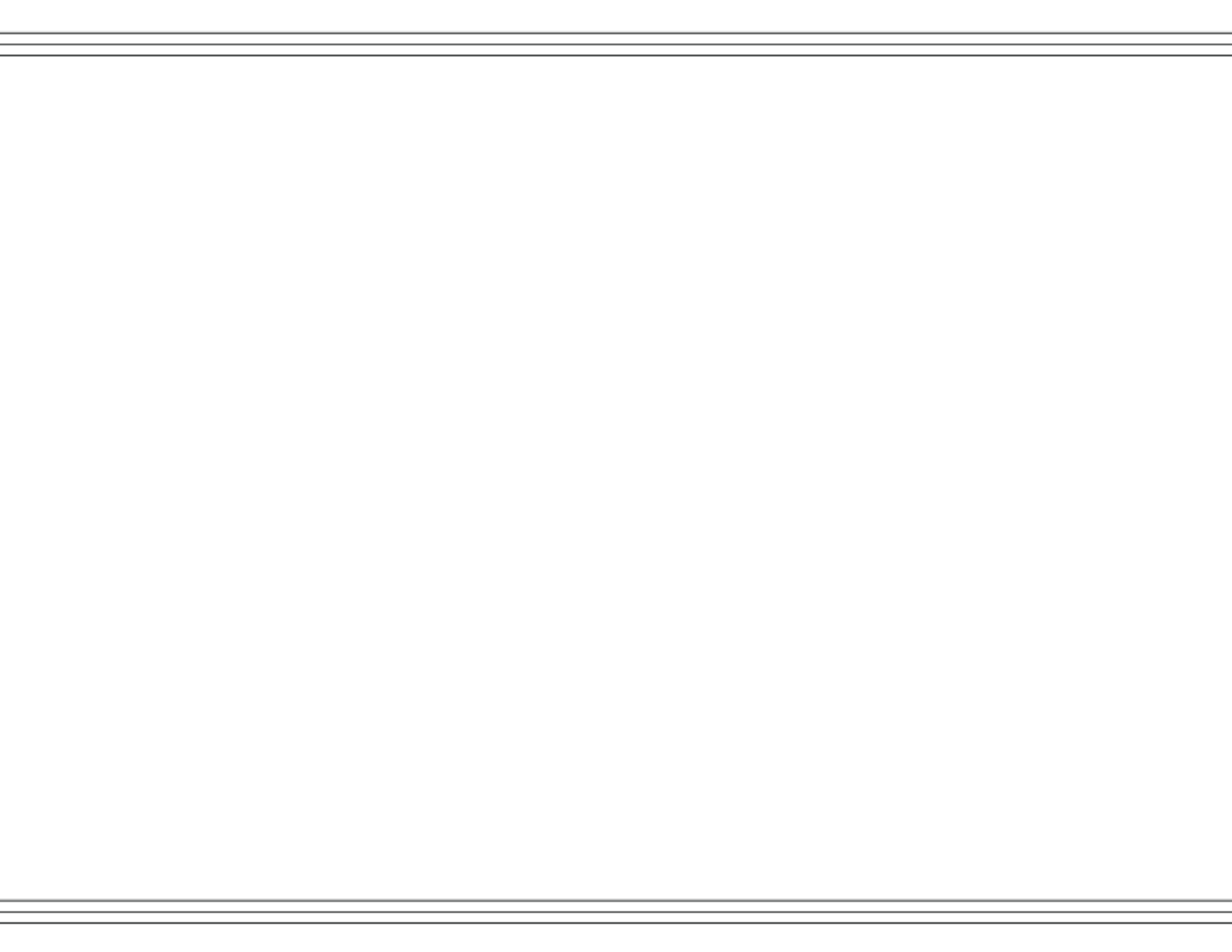

This report shows that the federal courts of the Seventh Circuit continue to be busy and productive.

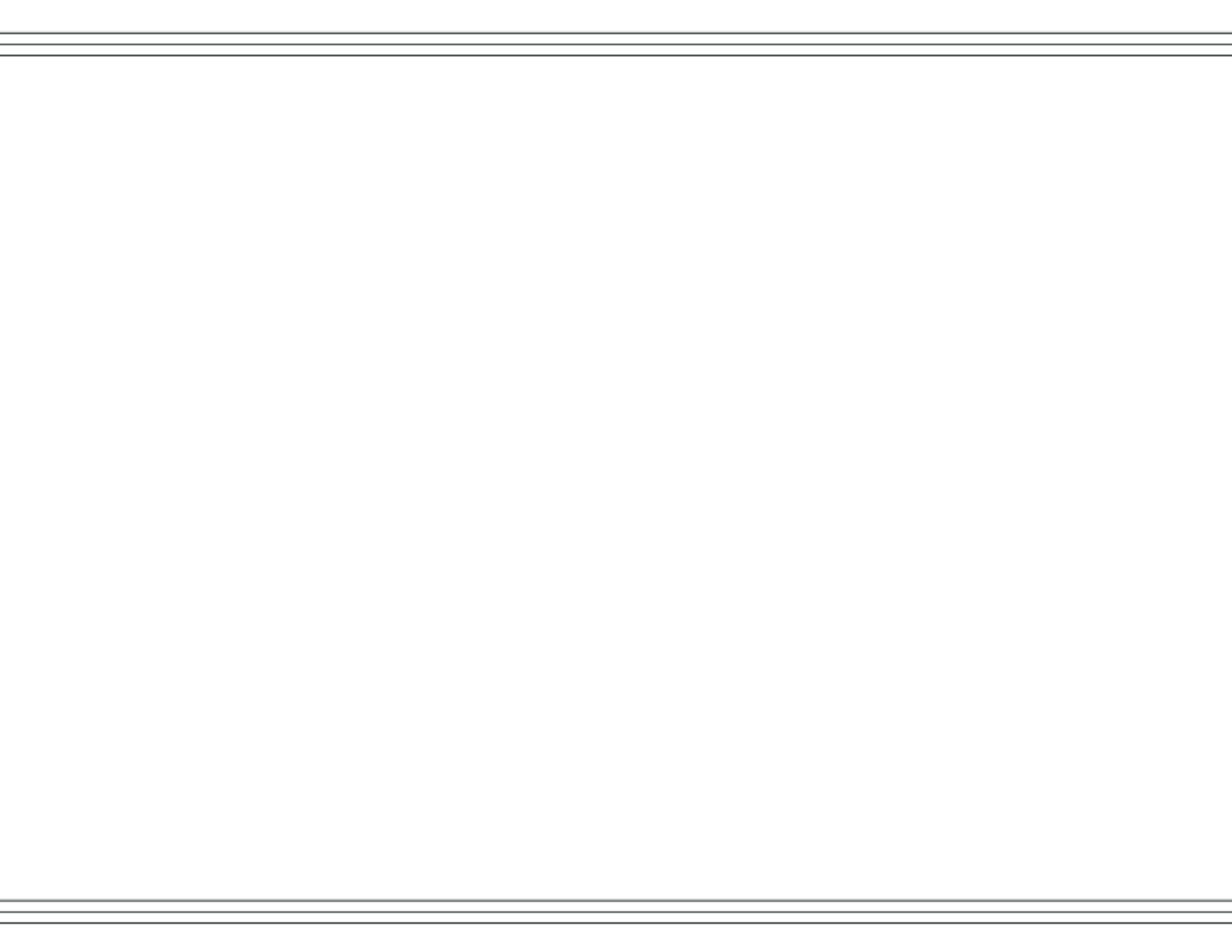
